Right now, our 'sterile' hood no longer meets required standards. That means sterile products like IV antibiotics and nutrition can only be used for a very short time. Many areas in the Pharmacy are outdated or far too small. Your investment will make each area more functional and efficient, with proper storage and handling systems to meet and exceed national standards.

With your support, our Pharmacy team will have the space they need to work efficiently, collaborate more effectively, and stay focused on delivering safe, high-quality care.

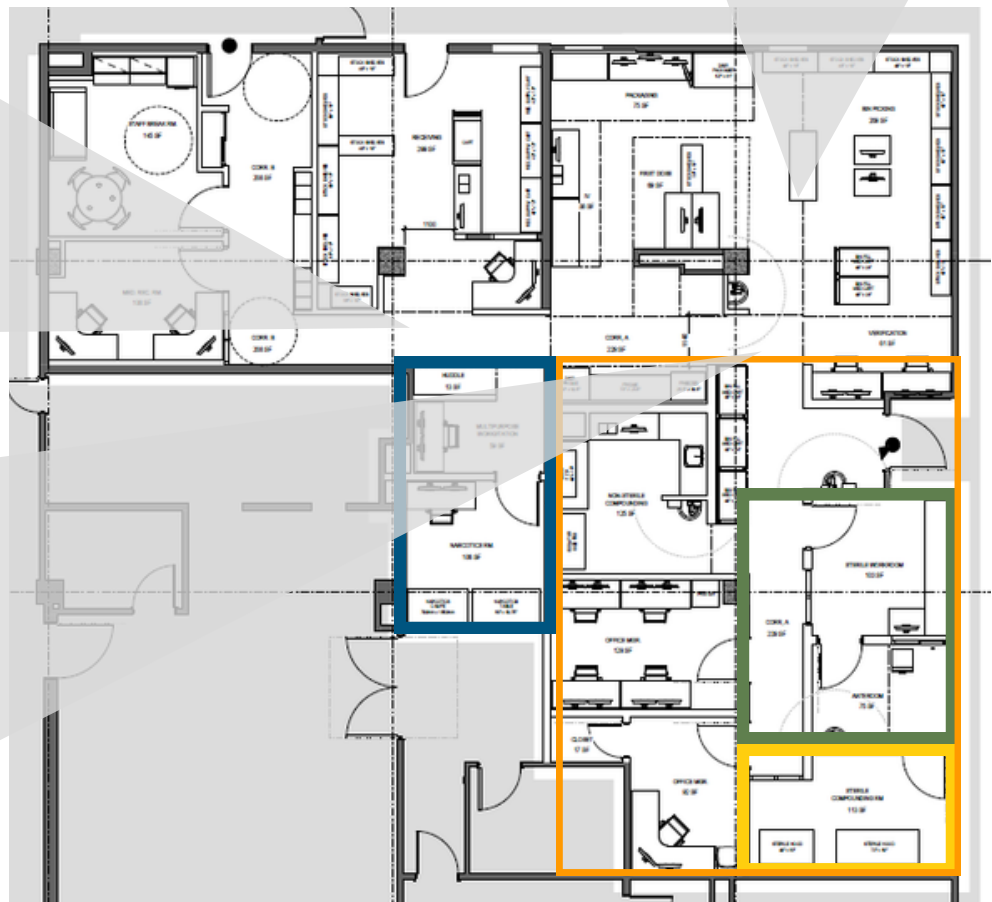
